Brother Knights,

Depending on when you are reading this, you may or may not have seen our Immaculate Conception Church parish bulletin. If you've read the bulletin first, then you were no doubt surprised by my decision to request senior status as a deacon. If you have not yet seen the bulletin, here is what that means.

When deacons minister within a parish, we are required to enter into a contract with the pastor, to determine exactly the extent of the deacon's ministry. The contract also obligates the parish to fund the deacon's required continuing education and annual retreat. In senior status, the contract, continuing education and retreat are no longer required. I am no longer obligated to the ministry. Bishop Daniel Thomas has granted me senior status effective June 1st, 2020. He also has granted me continued faculties to minister as I so chose.
